Thousands of Veterans' Graves Without Christmas Wreaths

(Colorado Springs, CO, November 1, 2023)

Five miles from downtown San Antonio lies one of the largest VA cemeteries in the nation, Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery. Established in 1937, the cemetery serves as the final resting place for over 167,000 Texas veterans, 12 of which were Medal of Honor Recipients. For the past 15 years, over the holidays, the people of Texas have donated live remembrance wreaths for these graves. But there have never been enough wreaths for **all** the graves. Last year, on Christmas morning, 75% of the graves at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery did **not** have a wreath. This year, at **SanAntonioHonor.com**, the people of San Antonio are being asked to change that. This is according to David Bolser, CEO of Senior Veterans, Inc. a 501 (c) 3 public charity.

Bolser continues, “We created a secure site, **SanAntonioHonor.com**, for people to donate wreaths. Additionally, we are sending this heart-warming story to the ABC, CBS, NBC, and FOX stations in San Antonio. We are asking the stations to broadcast this story for their viewers during the week preceding Veterans Day.” Veterans Day is Saturday, November 11, 2023.

These hand-made fir wreaths are just \$17. Donations **must** be received at **SanAntonioHonor.com** by **November 30**. All wreaths will be placed on December 16, 2023, at 11:00 am. This event is open to the public.
